SMS System

How does this system work?

Each of the 624 urban bus stops currently in service is identified with a number.

Send a SMS with the following text: **EMTUSA space p stop number** to 217213.

The text can be written with lowercase or capital letters. (*Example: Emtusa p78*)

What kind of information I will receive?

You will instantly receive a message stating the minutes left for the arrival of the next buses of the line or lines assigned to that stop.

(*Example: EMTUSA informa: L10 a SOMIO (CANDENAL) 2 min. L4 a VIESQUES 3 min. L20 a SOMIO (LA PIPA) 12 min.*)

The maximum length of the message is 160 characters, the maximum SMS length.

How much is it?

Same as a standard SMS.

What advantages has it got?

You can receive information on service in real time for the whole network of stops. Furthermore, it is not necessary to be at the stop to make the query. If you know the bus stop number you are interested in, you can send the SMS and receive the information from any point (from home, from your office, from the street, etc.)

Is it already operating?

The system is already in operation. Every bus stop, the posts as well as the shelters, have an identification number, as well as user instructions.

On the left side of the document you will find the number corresponding to each stop, then the identification name and next the bus lines stopping at each bus stop marked with a cross.
